The committee coordinates with departmental heads and subcommittees for timetable scheduling, integration of subjects, assessment planning, AETCOM implementation, elective postings and alignment of learning objectives with competencies. The Dean/Principal, Academic Coordinator and departmental faculty ensure that appropriate teaching-learning methods are used, including lectures, small group discussions, tutorials, bedside clinics, demonstrations, skill laboratory training, self-directed learning, early clinical exposure, integrated teaching and simulation-based learning. Regular academic reviews, student feedback, faculty meetings and internal audits are conducted to assess the effectiveness of instructional methods. The revision aimed to develop clinically competent, ethical, communicative and community-oriented Indian Medical Graduates in accordance with modern medical education standards.
